Synopsis:

How to Follow Strangers (HTFS) has two interconnected stories. The first one is inspired by a true account of a woman who died in her Manhattan apartment and remained there *a year* before her body was found, decomposing in a crisp Chanel suit. One of the main characters in *HTFS*, a young man named Casey, becomes so obsessed with this urban tragedy that he fakes his own disappearance, wondering if anyone will notice.

The second storyline begins when Ellie, a young woman who sees Casey everyday as part of her regular commute actually *does* notice that he goes missing. When Ellie unintentionally runs into Casey outside of their normal interaction, she begins to follow him, setting off a series of incidents that will bind them together.
